

TROPICAL MUFFINS

| | | |
|--------------------|-----------------------|--|
| 1/4 c. soft butter | 1 1/2 tsp rum extract | 1/2 tsp salt |
| 1/2 c sugar | 1 1/2 c flour | 1 8oz. can crushed pineapple (drained) |
| 1 lg room temp egg | 1 tsp baking powder | 1/2 c coconut |
| 1 c sour cream | 1 tsp baking soda | 1/3 c chopped pecans |

In large bowl, cream butter and sugar til light and fluffy. Beat egg, sour cream and extract. Combine flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt. Stir into creamed mixture just until moistened. Fold in pineapple, coconut and pecans.

Fill muffin cups 2/3 full Bake at 375 for 22-25 minutes. Cool 5 minutes before removing pan to wire rack.

CINNAMON APPLE CAKE

| | | |
|--------------------------|------------------------|-----------------------------|
| 1 3/4 c. sugar (divided) | 2 eggs | 2 tsp. Cinnamon |
| 1/2 c soft butter | 1 2/2 c flour | 3 c. chopped, peeled apples |
| 1 tsp. vanilla | 1 1/2 t. baking powder | |
| 6 oz. soft cream cheese | 1/4 tsp. salt | |

Beat 1 1/2 c sugar, butter, vanilla and cream cheese at med. speed until well blended. Add eggs, 1 at a time, combine flour, baking powder and salt. Add to creamed mixture beating at low speed until blended. Combine 1/4 c. sugar and cinnamon. Sprinkle 2 Tablespoons over apples then stir apples into batter. Pour batter into an 8" springform pan. Sprinkle with remaining cinnamon and sugar mix.

Bake at 350 for 1 hour 15 minutes or until cake pulls away from sides of pan. Completely cool.

CHEWY TOFFEE BIT COOKIES

|-----------------|---------------|------------------------------|
| 2 1/4 c. flour | 1/2 t salt | 3/4 packed light brown sugar |
| 1 t baking soda | 1 tsp vanilla | 10 oz toffee bits |
| 1/2 c butter | 2 eggs | |

Stir together flour, baking soda and salt. In a large bowl, beat butter, sugar, brown sugar and vanilla til well blended. Add eggs and blend thoroughly. Gradually add flour mixture and mix well. Stir in toffee bits. Drop by rounded teaspoonfuls onto a lightly greased cookie sheet. Bake 9-12 min. at 350 degrees. Cool slightly, remove from cookie sheets and cool completely

LEMON BARS

Crust

2 c. flour
 1 c butter
 1/2 c. powdered sugar


Blend, press into 13x9 pan.
 Bake at 350 for 25 minutes

Filling

4 beaten eggs
 2 c sugar
 1/2 c lemon juice
 4 TBLS Flour

Mix 4 beaten eggs with 2 cups sugar, 1/2 c. lemon juice, 4 Tablespoons of flour and 3 teaspoons of baking powder. Pour over baked crust. Immediately return to oven for 25 minutes. Sprinkle with powdered sugar


